

Route 3

River Skerne

Red Hall

Route – 40 minutes

This cycle ride follows the River Skerne through Rockwell Local Nature Reserve and continues to Red Hall. The majority of this route is off road or on quiet streets.

- Start at the bridge near the Five Arches railway bridge over the River Skerne (on the North side next to the Chimney sculpture) in Rockwell Nature Reserve. Continue along this route heading towards Haughton Road and cross the river at the next bridge you come to.
- Cross Haughton Road and continue on the riverside path. At a fork in the path turn right. At the top of the bank turn left and through the barrier. Take the cycle path to your left that crosses the green space to the shop.
- Cycle on to the road at this point, following Headingley Crescent out and turn right onto Coombe Drive. Continue along Coombe Drive until you reach McMullen Road where you will be able to turn right onto the off road path or turn left onto the off road path. Cross McMullen Road and then turn right. Continue along McMullen Road until you reach Haughton Road. Cross to the opposite side of Haughton Road and rejoin the riverside path.
- When you reach the first bridge, cross it and follow the path along the opposite bank of the river. You will reach the start point after about 5 minutes of cycling.
